Nevertheless, we would encourage you to opt for higher numbers. Reading a larger number of abstracts usually makes it easier to evaluate the individual one; and as a side effect usually improves the quality of the reviews.

If you are NOT interested in reviewing for 2016 could you please reply to this email before the close of business Friday October 31st. If you do not respond to this email then we will take it as an indication that you are prepared to continue as a reviewer.

If you are willing to continue being a reviewer for DH 2016 then please visit ConfTool (<https://www.conftool.pro/dh2016/>) and ensure your details are up to date. In particular check that you have selected your Priority Topics, indicated your maximum number of reviews and confirmed the Reviewer Confidentiality Agreement. Please also make sure to select in the list of topics the languages in which you can read reviews.

Digital Humanities 2016 conference will take place in Kraków, Poland; this is only the second time (after Debrecen 1998) that the conference comes to Central/Eastern Europe. The region's rich past and its recent rapid growth has inspired the conference theme, 'Digital Identities: the Past and the Future'.

We look forward to your continued involvement in DH 2016!
